Experience IMMI: A performance on imaginary culture – A night of art and music, Thursday 6 September, from 6:30pm

Located just off Stamford Court between Stuart Street and Wright Street, the Minor Works building has been transformed into a hub for creative expression.

Artist-in-residence Kaspar Schmidt Mumm has used the residency to continue his quest to develop a language and identity for the cultural hybrid citizen – extending the collaborative work IMMI; an unidentified culture living in the cracks of society.

On Thursday the 6th of September, Kaspar and his artistic collaborators, including poets and musicians, will be holding a musical performance, artist talk and developmental showing to celebrate the end of his residency. This is not only a great opportunity to see how this experimental artist's body of work has evolved, but to explore how the Minor Works building has been used as a site for creativity.

The ART WORKS pilot launched in April 2018 has included Kaspar as Artist-In-Residence, Writer-In-Residence Rayleen Forester, zine workshops with Georgina Chaddington, sustainable printmaking with Hanah Williams and paper jewellery workshops with Sahr Bashir.

The Minor Works building has been the site of the ART WORKS program, a new initiative delivered by Guildhouse in partnership with the City of Adelaide. This program of residencies and creative workshops is designed to provide a city-based platform for artists to pursue new ways of working and engaging with audiences.
