

## EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST: LEFEVRE COMMUNITY STADIUM CAFÉ - MURAL

Expressions are sought from South Australian Artists / Artist teams to design and paint an intricate mural on an interior wall in The Lefevre Community Stadium, 541 Victoria Road, Osborne.

The City of Port Adelaide Enfield is looking for Artists / Artist teams to paint an interior wall, located on Kaurana Country, in The Lefevre Community Stadium. The Artist / Artist team will be chosen based upon experience, work examples, ability to collaborate with stakeholders and the quality of their application.

Expressions of Interest are due by 11:59PM (ACDST) on 27 November 2022.

### Project Vision

The City of PAE is producing a unique, creative and distinctive collection of places that are created and cared for through strong partnerships between Council, Community and other Stakeholders. As part of the upgrades being carried out to spaces in the Lefevre Community Stadium, the current Meeting Room 1, will be repurposed as a café space, for people to gather and relax, whilst enjoying all that the café has to offer.

The LeFevre Community Stadium is located at 541 Victoria Road, Osborne. Situated on the Lefevre Peninsula, the Community Stadium is home to many weekly community programs, that are highly attended, check out <https://www.facebook.com/LefevreCommunityStadium/> to get an idea of what goes on there.

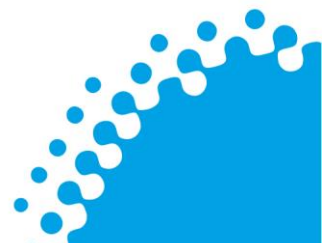

**The Successful applicant will:**

- Be a resident of Australia.
- Be required to work with The City of PAE and project stakeholders.
- Plan to have a contemporary response that is bright, fun, busy, detailed and breathes life into this new café space.
- Have public liability insurance for \$10,000,000.

**The mural will:**

- Be intricate and highly detailed work, in a way that draws the viewer in to explore the mural.
- Be a complex illustration that contains “discoverable” elements.
- Promote local culture, history, creativity, pride and identity.
- Be high-quality, contemporary, original work.
- Take into consideration the usage and location of the site.
- Be reflective and responsive to the local environment.
- Add life and colour to the newly created café space.
- Enrich the public environment.
- Create a strong sense of place.
- Be sensitive to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures, particularly local Kaurna culture.

**Practical considerations**

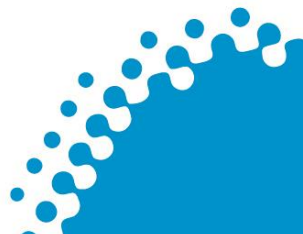
- The artwork will be painted on the interior wall of the proposed café area, inside the Lefevre Community Stadium.
- Measurements: 5.2m wide x 2.6m high, please note the windows have not been included in the total area calculated – Total 11.56m<sup>2</sup> (approx).
- City of PAE is the key stakeholder in the project.
- The City of PAE as the commissioner of the work has ongoing responsibility for the maintenance and care of the mural.
- The City of PAE will pay for and apply anti-graffiti coating to the finished mural.
- A risk assessment must be made prior to commencing work to ensure a safe working environment and WHS practices adhered to.

**Budget**

- The specific budget is \$3,500 ex GST for design, meetings, administration, materials and implementation.

**Other considerations**

- This EOI is open to Artists residing in Australia.
- Artists residing in The City of Port Adelaide Enfield area are encouraged to apply.
- The successful applicant will be chosen through a selection panel, consisting of PAE staff.
- The successful applicant must be available to meet with City of PAE staff to discuss and refine the mural design.

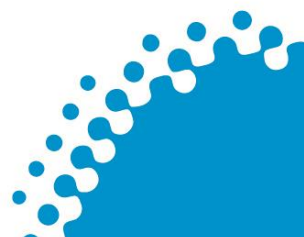


## Timeline

27 November 2022	EOI due at 11:59PM (ACDST)
Week of 28 November 2022	Artist(s) selected for the Lefevre Community Stadium Café mural
Early December 2022	Artist to design the mural concept
Early December 2022	City of PAE to sign off on the mural concept
Mid - late December 2022	Mural to be painted

### Expressions of Interest (EOI)

- Your EOI should include 1 page (max) outlining your concept for the project and how you would go about delivering on it.
- Supporting images of previous work that you believe are relevant to your proposal (5 max).
- Artist resume detailing relevant skills and / or experience.
- 2 Referees (name and contact details only).
- The successful application will be decided upon by a selection panel with representatives from the City of PAE.
